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


- Language
 - A system of communication through speech
 - A collection of sounds that a group of people understand to have the same meaning
- Literary tradition
 - A system of written communication

- Language family
 - A collection of languages related through a common ancestral language
 - Existed before written history



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
LANGUAGE FAMILIES



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LANGUAGE FAMILY TREE


- Language branch
 - A collection of languages within a family related through a common ancestral language
 - Existed several thousand years ago
 - Confirmation through linguistic similarities and archeological evidence



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LANGUAGE FAMILY TREE


- Language group
 - A collection of languages within a branch that share a common origin in the relatively recent past
 - Display few differences in grammar and vocabulary



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LANGUAGE FAMILY TREE

- Native speakers
 - People for whom the language is their first language
- Language superfamilies
 - A handful of large language families that today's language families are descended from
 - Existed tens of thousands of years ago



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
LANGUAGE FAMILY TREE




INDO - EUROPEAN BRANCHES



GERMANIC BRANCH OF INDO - EUROPEAN





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
ROMANCE BRANCH OF INDO - EUROPEAN




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- Migration is the key diffusion process.

 - Peace theory


ORIGIN AND DIFFUSION OF INDO - EUROPEAN: NOMADIC WARRIOR THEORY



ORIGIN AND DIFFUSION OF INDO - EUROPEAN: SEDENTARY FARMER THEORY




INVASIONS OF ENGLAND

OFFICIAL LANGUAGES IN SUB-SAHARAN AFRICA




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- Dialect

 - Are generally mutually intelligible


- Isogloss




- Lingua franca

5.7 Isolated, Endangered, and Extinct Languages

- Isolated languages
 - Languages unrelated to any other
 - Are not attached to any language family



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ISOLATED LANGUAGE: BASQUE

- Extinct languages
 - Languages that are no longer spoken or read in daily activities by anyone in the world
 - Are not attached to any language family



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REVIVAL OF AN EXTINCT LANGUAGE: HEBREW

- Preserving endangered languages
 - ~473 endangered languages
 - Preserved Celtic languages
 - Irish Gaelic
 - Scottish Gaelic
 - Welsh
 - Cornish
 - Breton
 - Political and military strength determines survival



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

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
FRENCH IN CANADA: "HELLO"


